Due to the heatwave, some stalls had to move indoors so the prizes didn't melt



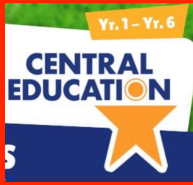
The pizzas went down a treat - thanks to Papa Johns for delivering the pizzas and donating their profits

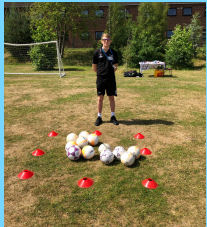
THE BEECH HOUSE
